- Accessibility compliance for ADA users
- Integration with security systems, such as access cards or turnstiles

For buildings with multiple elevators, the distribution box may also manage networked wiring, including CAT6 or fiber connections, to coordinate digital controls, group logic, and elevator car assignments.
