Key Requirements for Distribution Boxes

- Safety and Protection:** Distribution boxes must include proper circuit breakers, fuses, and protective devices to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electrical hazards.
- Installation Standards:** Boxes must be installed according to EVS and EN standards, ensuring correct grounding, spacing, and accessibility for maintenance.
- Labeling and Identification:** All circuits and components inside the distribution box must be clearly labeled to comply with safety and operational regulations.
- Environmental and Mechanical Requirements:** Boxes must be resistant to environmental factors such as moisture, dust, and temperature variations, following EN 61439 series standards for low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies.
- Connection to the Network:** Distribution boxes must be compatible with the local network voltage levels (typically 0.4–35 kV for distribution...
