

# Exposed circuit breaker in distribution box

### Safety Considerations

Do not touch exposed parts: Live terminals and busbars carry high voltage and can cause serious injury or death. Turn off the main breaker: Before working inside the panel, switch off the main breaker to de-energize branch circuits. In some Canadian panels, the main breaker is isolated so that no live parts are exposed when servicing. Use insulated tools and protective gear: Gloves, safety glasses, and insulated screwdrivers reduce the risk of accidental contact. Maintain proper enclosure: Ensure the panel cover is replaced after servicing to prevent accidental exposure to live parts.

### Maintenance and Inspection

Regular inspection of the distribution box is essential to prevent hazards: Check for loose connections or signs of overheating. Ensure circuit breakers are properly seated and rated for their circuits. Keep the panel free of dust and debris, which can reduce insulation effectiveness. Verify that grounding and neutral connections are secure to maintain electrical safety.
