Redundancy and Reliability Redundancy ensures continuous operation during hardware failures. Key features include dual power supplies, swappable fan modules, redundant routing protocols like HSRP or VRRP, and hot-swappable line cards. These features prevent downtime and maintain network stability.

Security Features Core switches are central to network security. Features such as ACLs, ARP protection, VLAN segmentation, VPN support, and 802.1X authentication help protect against unauthorized access and attacks, safeguarding the network backbone.

Scalability and Modularity Modular or stackable designs allow the network to grow without replacing the entire switch. This includes support for additional line cards, stacking ports, and link aggregation, which ensures the network can adapt to increasing traffic demands.
