Ensure the box is level and properly aligned.
- Introducing Fiber Cables** Feed the optical cable through the designated cable inlet using a grommet to secure it. Use pre-terminated branch fiber jumpers or pigtails for easier connection. Maintain sufficient slack to prevent tension when accessing the front panel; typically, a minimum of 31 inches between key points is recommended.
- Splicing and Termination** Clean fiber ends with 99% isopropyl alcohol and lint-free wipes. Precision cleaving ensures 90-degree fiber ends for optimal splicing. Perform fusion splicing to join incoming fibers to pigtails inside the FDB. Secure splices in trays using heat-shrink sleeves to protect joints.
- Fiber Routing and Management** Route fibers along bending radius control clips to prevent sharp bends...
