- AzerTelecom / Azerconnect Group:** As part of the Trans-Caspian Fiber Optic Cable and the Digital Silk Way initiative, AzerTelecom is a key state-backed operator expanding fiber optic infrastructure across Azerbaijan, including Baku, Sumgayit, Ganja, and other major cities, as well as recently liberated territories (submarinenetworks.com)

Regional Coverage

Azerbaijan has implemented a Fiber to the Home (FTTH) program, extending fiber optic lines directly to apartments and offices. High-speed networks are available in Baku, Sumgayit, Ganja, Khirdalan, Shirvan, Mingachevir, and gradually expanding to smaller towns and rural areas. State-owned backbone operators like Aztelekom and Baktelecom are actively laying regional fiber optic lines to improve connectivity in remote villages (caliber.az)

Purchasing Fiber Optic Cables

For businesses or technical installations, fiber optic cables can be sourced from local distributors and suppliers specializing in optical fibers, bundles, and cables. The Azerbaijani market has seen significant growth in optical fiber consumption, with exports and domestic supply available for commercial and industrial use (indexbox.io)
