Splicing: Place the fibers in a fusion splicer. The device aligns the fibers automatically and applies an electric arc to fuse them together.

Protection: Cover the splice with a protective sleeve to prevent mechanical damage and environmental exposure.

Testing: Measure the splice loss using an optical time-domain reflectometer (OTDR) to ensure it meets standards such as ITU-T G.652.
