 - Rear Side:** Longer fiber cables enter the back of the panel, where they are terminated and routed to the front adapters (Fibconet Communicate). This arrangement allows for cross-connections without the need for expensive switching equipment.
- Connector Types**

Fiber patch panels support various connector types, each compatible with specific fiber cables:

 - LC (Lucent Connector):** Small form factor, widely used in data centers.
 - SC (Subscriber Connector):** Push-pull design, common for single-mode and multimode fibers.
 - ST (Straight Tip):** Bayonet-style connector, often used in legacy networks.
 - FC (Ferrule Connector):** Screw-on type, used in high-vibration environments.
 - MTP/MPO:** Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications (Fibconet Communicate).

Connector choice depends on fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and network requirements.

Adapters are mounted inside the patch panel to interface between incoming fibers and patch cords. They provide a secure and precise alignment for optical signals, minimizing insertion loss and back reflecti...
