

Fiber Optic Splice Box Fixing Steps

Cable Preparation Begin by removing the outer jacket of the optical cable, along with any shielding or armor if present, to expose the loose tubes. Connect and ground the cable's shield layer. Wrap self-adhesive sealing tape between the two sealing rings to create a sealed cable end. Secure the cable to the closure base using a hose clamp, ensuring it is tightly fastened.

Fiber Arrangement in Splice Trays Inside the closure, fibers should be carefully coiled and placed in splice trays to prevent stress or pinching. Loose tube cables typically extend from the closure entrance to the tray, with about 1 meter of bare fiber on each side of the splice organized in the tray. For ribbon fibers, ensure proper routing to avoid bending in restricted directions. Use nylon cable ties to secure fibers at the tray entrance.

Splicing Methods Fiber splicing can be performed using fusion splicing or mechanical splicing. Fusion splicing uses an electric arc to permanently join fibers, offering minimal signal loss and high reliability, while mechanical splicing aligns fibers with an index-matching gel, which is faster but less permanent.

After splicing, coil any remaining fiber neatly in the tray and cover the fusion plate securely.
