

Fiber Optic Switch Serial Port Login

Terminal Emulator Configuration Open a terminal emulator such as HyperTerminal (Windows), TERM, TIP, or Kermit (UNIX/Linux). Configure the serial connection: Bits per second (baud rate): 9600 Data bits: 8 Parity: None Stop bits: 1 Flow control: None. Disable other serial communication programs to avoid conflicts.

Logging In Power on the switch and wait for POST (Power-On Self-Test) to complete. The port status and LEDs should indicate normal operation. Press Enter in the terminal emulator to display the login prompt. Use default credentials: Username: admin Password: password Change the default password when prompted during the initial login.

Additional Configuration After login, you can configure the switch with a static IP address or use DHCP for automatic network settings. Ensure the management Ethernet port is connected if using DHCP. For advanced management, you can later enable SSH or Telnet once the IP is configured. Following these steps ensures a successful serial port login to a fiber optic switch, allowing you to perform initial setup, configuration, and troubleshooting.
