

Fiber optic broadband connection to router plug

- Ensure the router** is placed near a power source and in a dry, ventilated area.
- Power On the Router** Plug in the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
- Access the router's configuration interface** via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) if manual setup is required.
- Verify the Connection** Check the ONT and router lights: a solid green power light on the ONT indicates proper operation.
- Test internet connectivity** on a device to ensure the setup is complete.

Tips and Precautions

- Handle fiber cables carefully:** Avoid bending or touching the glass connectors to prevent signal loss.
- Use high-quality Ethernet cables:** Cat6a or higher preserves fiber speeds up to 10 Gbps.
- Router placement:** Central location improves Wi-Fi coverage; avoid heat sources and moisture.
