The ONT requires a dedicated power source and is typically placed near other networking equipment for efficient distribution. In some setups, the ONT and router are combined into a single device, while larger homes may use mesh systems for broader Wi-Fi coverage . Internal Fiber Routing Running fiber inside the house requires careful planning to avoid bends, heat, or high-traffic areas that could damage the delicate glass fibers . Key considerations include: Pathway selection: Use basements, attics, or existing low-voltage conduits to minimize cable length and sharp turns .
