

Fiber optic cable connecting Afghanistan

Afghanistan has developed a 4,000 km fiber optic network connecting 24 provinces, with plans to expand to 7,000 km and link all 34 provinces, while also establishing international connections to neighboring countries. These international links reduce reliance on costly satellite systems and provide access to global data hubs at competitive prices. The network is also part of the broader Digital Silk Road initiative, aiming to enhance regional connectivity and integrate Afghanistan into transcontinental communication routes. Governance and Regulation The network is government-owned and managed by three entities: Afghan Telecom (management), the Ministry of Communication & IT (deployment), and the Afghanistan Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (ATRA) (regulation). ATRA oversees pricing, ensures affordable access, and has drafted an open access policy to encourage private sector investment in fiber optic infrastructure.
