

Fiber optic cables must be laid at one location per day

Project Scheduling The pace of installation is determined by crew size, equipment, route complexity, and environmental conditions. Large-scale deployments often schedule multiple crews to work on different segments simultaneously, optimizing efficiency and reducing overall project duration . Therefore, while a single crew may focus on one location per day for quality control, there is no universal rule restricting fiber installation to one...
