Step 5: Manage Cable Routing and Bend Radius Route the patch cord carefully, maintaining the minimum bend radius (typically 400 mm or more for jumpers) to prevent stress and signal loss. Use cable trays, Velcro ties, or raceways to organize the cables and prevent twisting or tangling.
