Flexibility: Pigtails allow factory-quality connectors to be integrated into field-installed fiber networks without the need for on-site connector polishing, saving time and ensuring reliability.

In summary, when referring to the "end face" of a fiber optic pigtail, the connector end is the polished, factory-terminated side for equipment connection, and the bare fiber end is the side used for splicing into the network. This distinction is critical for proper installation and network performance.
