Overview

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber —typically 0.5m to 2m—that has a factory-terminated connector on one end and bare fiber on the other end. They are the bridge between fiber optic cables in the field and the equipment or patch panels that manage them. Get the wrong connector type, the wrong polish, or skip proper fusion splicing technique—and you're looking at elevated signal loss, increased back reflection, and a. A pigtail fiber indicates a short length of optical fiber cable that has a pigtail connector (for example, SC, FC, ST, LC, etc. The bare end is fusion-spliced to a trunk or distribution cable inside a splice tray or fiber distribution box. Common types include single-mode OS2, multimode OM3/OM4.
