4. **Advanced Features:** Look for routers with Quality of Service (QoS) to prioritize traffic, multi-band support (dual or tri-band) to reduce congestion, robust security protocols, and VPN support for remote work or secure connections. Low-latency features are important for gaming or video conferencing.
5. **Coverage Considerations:** For larger homes or multi-story buildings, consider mesh WiFi systems or WiFi extenders to eliminate dead zones and maintain consistent speeds throughout the home.

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Converts fiber light signals into electrical signals for your router. The ONT is typically installed by your ISP and is essential for connecting your fiber service to your home network.
- Ethernet Cables:** High-quality cables (Cat6 or higher) are recommended to connect the ONT to your router and devices to support gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds.
