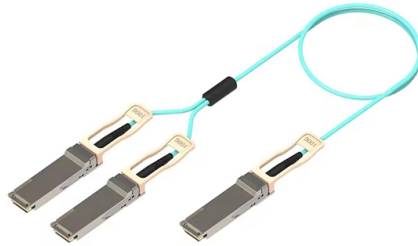

2. Cement Splicing Cement splicing uses a chemical film cement to bond the film ends. The emulsion is removed from the splice area, and the film bases are chemically welded together. This method is permanent and is typically used for negative films or release prints. Cement splices often involve a small overlap area, with dimensions standardized for different film formats (e.g., 0.156 inch for 35 mm film) to ensure durability. Cement splicing is less suitable for polyester films, which do not bond with standard cement.
