Design Considerations

Cover Shape: Dome, flat, peaked, corrugated, or finned designs influence airflow, water runoff, and structural strength. Corrugated or peaked covers are better for outdoor or seismic-prone areas, while flat covers are preferred in corridors or data centers for space efficiency and aesthetics.

Flanged or Hinged Covers: Adding flanges improves sealing in clean environments, and hinged designs allow easy maintenance access without removing the cover entirely.

Ventilation: Finned or perforated covers enhance airflow for heat dissipation, while solid covers provide maximum protection against dust, debris, and EMI/RFI interference...
