

Fireproofing and Sealing Construction Plan for Cable Trays

Topcoat: Apply a durable topcoat with weather-resistant and decorative qualities, ensuring a smooth, uniform finish without drips or bubbles ().

3. Firestopping and Sealing Penetrations

Material Selection: Use fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or fire-resistant mineral wool for sealing openings where trays pass through walls, slabs, or panels ().

Installation: Place firestop packs in an orderly sequence, ensuring gaps between packs and cables do not exceed 1 cm² and packing thickness is at least 24 cm ().

Sealing: Seal all gaps inside and around metal trunking tightly, both internally and externally. Cover plates should be square, evenly painted, and properly dimensioned ().
