 - Solid-bottom trays:** Suitable for sensitive or corrosive environments.
 - Composite trays (FRP):** Non-conductive and corrosion-resistant for high-moisture or chemical areas .
- 3. Tray Sizing and Support**Calculate tray width and depth based on cable count, type, and spacing to prevent overheating and overfilling (typically not exceeding 40% of tray capacity), . Determine support spans according to manufacturer load charts and building structure. Common support methods include trapeze hangers for ceilings and cantilever wall brackets for vertical runs . Ensure supports are spaced properly, usually 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load .
- 4. Tray Installation**Install trays level, straight, and securely using connectors and fittings. For long runs, use cable tray rollers to prevent kinks and damage . Ensure mechanical integrity and compliance with NEC Article 392 and...
