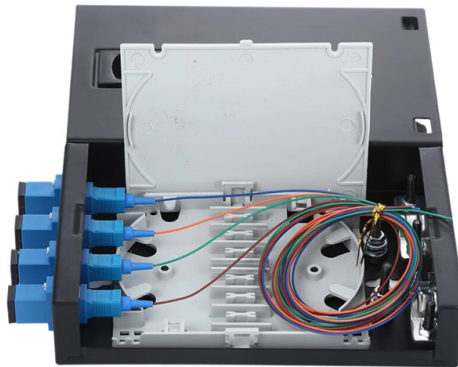

ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) optical cables are self-supporting, non-metallic cables ideal for aerial installation along power lines, while guiding optical cables typically rely on a supporting messenger wire for mechanical strength. The outer jacket, often UV-stabilized polyethylene or track-resistant material, protects against moisture, sunlight, and electrical tracking from high-voltage lines.

Installation and Applications: ADSS cables are designed to span long distances between towers (up to 700–1,500 feet or 460 meters) without additional support. They are ideal for telecommunications along high-voltage power lines, smart-grid networks, and FTTH deployments. Because they are dielectric, they are immune to electromagnetic interference and do not require grounding, simplifying installation near 220 kV or higher lines.
