Intumescent covers can be retrofitted to existing plastic consumer units, upgrading them to meet IET Wiring Regulations and European or British fire safety standards.

Fire-Resistant Junction and Connection Boxes For cable junctions and connections, specialized fire protection boxes ensure that electrical systems such as emergency lighting, smoke extractors, and pressure-boosting systems remain operational during a fire. These boxes are made from high-performance, heat-resistant materials like polycarbonate, which is non-conductive under fire conditions, preventing short circuits and maintaining system integrity.
