

How long is a cable tray support column



Overview

The NEC requires that cable trays must be supported by members at an interval specified by the cable tray manufacturer, but not more than 5 feet for horizontal runs to support the weight of the cables and other loads. The NEC has a requirement for ladder-type cable trays. Unlike a simple wire trough, which is typically a covered channel for shorter runs, cable trays provide a comprehensive support system for complex wiring paths over long. Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \text{Total Length} \div \text{Support Spacing} + 1$ $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. Cable tray supports are components used to fix and support. A cable support system consists of cable support lengths and system components, such as cable support fittings, support elements, mounting elements and system accessories. The cable support lengths and fittings can basically be designed as cable trays, cable ladders or mesh cable trays, in which. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements —width, depth, length, and material thickness—that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability. Crossbeam: A horizontal structural member that supports the cable tray, typically made of angle steel. Hanger rod: A vertical rod used to suspend. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
