

How long should optical cable be laid at one time

- Bend Radius:** Maintain a minimum bend radius of 20 times the cable diameter during pulling and 10 times the diameter after installation to prevent fiber damage.
- Twisting and Loops:** Use figure-8 loops when laying cable on the ground to prevent twisting, and avoid small circles or surges.
- Support and Protection:** Support cables at frequent intervals using hand-tightened cable ties or hook-and-loop fasteners, and use guiding devices or protective tubes at bends, crossovers, or conduit entries.
- Lubrication:** For long conduit pulls, use lubricants compatible with the cable jacket to reduce friction and prevent damage.
