Height: Minimum headroom of 2.0 meters (6 ft 6 in) from floor to ceiling or overhead obstruction is required. Practical Implications Ensure the machine is positioned outside the required working space to allow safe inspection, maintenance, and emergency egress. The working space must remain clear of storage, tools, or other obstructions. If the machine or other equipment is across an aisle, Condition 2 may apply, allowing slightly reduced clearance if only qualified personnel access the area simultaneously.
