- Building layout:** Cable routing, bends, and obstacles can require extra length to reach endpoints safely.

Practical Recommendation

For most indoor installations, planning for 300–500 meters of multimode fiber is sufficient to cover a single building or data center floor. If future expansion or higher-speed upgrades are anticipated, using OM3 or OM4 fiber with some spare length is recommended to avoid repurchasing cables. This ensures reliable signal transmission while maintaining flexibility for network growth.
