- Layer-3 (Multilayer) Switches:** Can perform routing functions, allowing them to connect multiple IP networks directly, effectively acting as both a switch and a router.

Connecting Multiple Networks A single switch can connect multiple networks primarily through VLANs (Virtual LANs). Each VLAN acts as a separate logical network, so a managed switch with VLAN support can handle dozens of networks depending on its configuration and port capacity. Layer-3 switches can further route traffic between these VLANs, effectively connecting multiple networks without additional routers.

Scalability Switches can be stacked or cascaded, allowing multiple switches to interconnect and expand the number of devices and networks supported. While this increases capacity, it also adds complexity in management and configuration.
