

# How many routers can a fiber optic network cable connect to

These secondary routers can operate in Access Point mode to extend Wi-Fi coverage or provide extra LAN ports ( ). Subnet Configuration: For advanced setups, secondary routers can be configured on different subnets with point-to-point links to route traffic through the primary router ( ). This setup allows multiple routers to share the same fiber connection without requiring multiple public IP addresses. Fiber Core Considerations If you are designing a network with multiple endpoints, the number of fiber cores in the cable may determine how many devices can be connected in a point-to-point manner. For example, a multi-core fiber cable can support multiple connections, but using a single core for multiple devices requires splicing, which increases signal loss and reduces transmission quality ( ).
