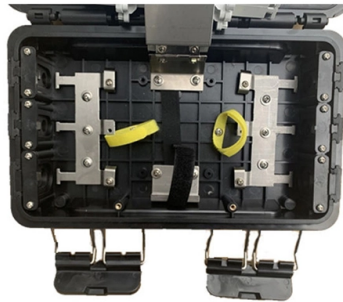


How to assign colors to cable trays

Cable trays can be color-coded in Revit or Navisworks using Object Styles, view filters, material assignments, or automated scripts to visually differentiate types, services, or sizes.

Assigning Colors in Revit

Select the Cable Tray: Locate the cable tray in a 2D or 3D view and click to select it. A bounding box will indicate selection.

Access Object Styles: Go to the Manage tab → Object Styles → Model Objects tab. Find the Cable Tray category and click the color box to choose a new color. This changes the color for all cable trays in the project.

Use View Filters for Specific Trays: To assign different colors to specific trays: Create a filter based on parameters like Type, Service, or Size. Apply the filter in the view. Set the surface pattern to Solid Fill and select the desired color.

Adjust Visibility/Graphics: Press VG or go to View → Visibility/Graphics to ensure cable trays are visible and filters are applied correctly.

Assigning Colors in Navisworks

Navisworks primarily recognizes materials, not Revit filters. Assign a material to each cable tray in Revit before exporting. Alternatively, create a selection set in Navisworks and apply an override color to differentiate trays.

Automating Color Assignment

Dynamo Scripts: You can automate color coding based on parameters such as Type, Elevation, Service Type, Size, Width, or Height. The script overrides colors in the view and can generate a legend for reference. Always back up your project before running scripts to prevent accidental changes.

Best Practices

Use consistent color schemes for similar types or services to improve readability. Maintain a legend in your project to indicate what each color represents. Apply view-specific overrides if you need different color schemes in different views without affecting the entire project. By combining Object Styles, filters, material assignments, and scripts, you can efficiently assign and manage colors for cable trays in both Revit and Navisworks, ensuring clarity in complex projects.
