Conduit and Burial Practices For underground installations, use appropriate conduits or direct burial methods. Loose tube and armored fiber cables are preferred for underground use due to their resistance to moisture, environmental changes, and mechanical stress. Typical burial depths range from 12–24 inches in urban areas and 24–48 inches in rural or high-traffic zones, depending on local regulations and soil conditions. Conduits should be continuous, smooth, and free of sharp bends to protect the cable during installation and maintenance.
