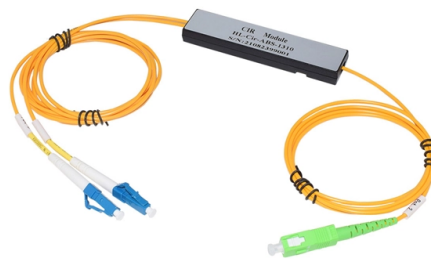


How to check the load on a distribution box
