

How to close the switch on the primary distribution box

- 6. Observe Safety Precautions** Always stand to the side of the switch when operating it, avoid touching live parts, and ensure no one is working on the circuits being energized.

Additional Notes

Visible Disconnection: Isolation switches provide a visible gap when open, so closing the switch restores the circuit physically and electrically.

Main Switch Function: The main switch controls the supply to the entire distribution box, so closing it will energize all downstream circuitry.
