Labeling and Documentation Clearly label each circuit with its function and area served (). Maintain a circuit chart inside or near the box for easy identification during maintenance or inspection.

Compliance and Testing Follow local electrical codes (e.g., NEC, IEC, BS 7671) and use UL/CE-certified components (). Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before powering on. Schedule regular maintenance and inspections to ensure long-term reliability ().
