

# How to connect a fiber optic cable to a front panel cable at home

**Step 5: Link the ONT to the Front Panel or Router** Use a Cat6 Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet output to your router or front panel interface. This allows the converted electrical signal to distribute internet throughout your home. If your setup includes a combo ONT/router unit, this step may be integrated.
