SFP modules support various fiber types (single-mode or multimode) and distances, and they are hot-swappable for flexibility. Some switches allow you to choose SFP modules based on site requirements, supporting distances up to 120 km. Media Converters If your switch does not have fiber ports, a media converter can bridge the connection. Media converters have one fiber port and one RJ45 Ethernet port, converting signals between the two media types. Multi-port media converters, such as 8 optical + 2 electrical ports, allow aggregation of multiple fiber links into a copper network, supporting full-duplex and auto MDI/MDIX functionality. Practical Considerations Port speed compatibility: Ensure the fiber and electrical ports support the same speed (10/100/1000 Mbps or 10 Gbps). Fiber type and wavelength: Match single-mode or multimode fiber and the correct wavelength for SFP modules. Distance: Fiber can ex...
