

How to connect a household fiber optic cable

Protect the cable with low-voltage conduit in open wall cavities or high-traffic areas, and secure it with soft Velcro ties to prevent crushing.

Step 4: Connect the ONT to Your Router Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. Place the router in a central location away from electromagnetic interference to maximize Wi-Fi coverage.
