

How to connect a switch to a local area network

If using a router, you can enable DHCP to automatically assign IP addresses. For a switch-only network without a router, assign IPs manually.

Step 4: Configure the Default Gateway (Optional) If devices need internet access, set the default gateway to the router's IP address. For a LAN without internet, the default gateway can be left blank or set to the switch's IP if it has management capabilities.

Step 5: Test the Network Verify connectivity by pinging devices from one another. Check that shared resources like printers or file folders are accessible. For managed switches, configure VLANs, port security, or traffic prioritization as needed.
