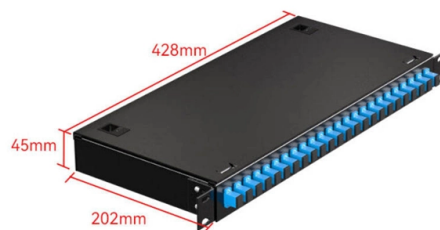


How to connect broadband to a fiber optic cable

Step 5: Optimize Your Network Place the router in a central location to reduce dead zones. Secure your network with strong passwords and updated firmware.
