

How to connect concealed wires in a distribution box

Step 4: Distribution Box Installation Mount the distribution box securely on the wall, ensuring it is level and stable. Inside the box, install circuit breakers, busbars, and terminal blocks according to your load requirements. Connect each conductor to its designated terminal: line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground. Use cable ties to organize wires neatly and leave...
