Connect the Main MCCB: Connect the three-phase supply lines (L1, L2, L3) to the input terminals of the MCCB. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral busbar. Connect the grounding wire to the earth busbar.

Connect Busbars: Use busbars to link the MCCB outputs to the input terminals of the MCBs. Ensure each phase is correctly aligned to maintain load balance across all three phases.

Connect MCBs to Circuits: Connect the line terminals of each MCB to the respective phase busbar. Connect the neutral of each circuit to the neutral busbar. Connect the earth wire of each circuit to the earth busbar.
