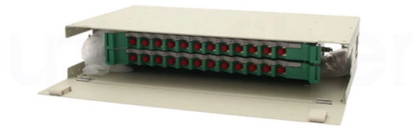

- 6. Secure and Manage Cables** Organize the cables neatly within the panel using trays or guides to prevent bending or stress. Avoid tight bends that can cause micro-bending losses and signal degradation.
- 7. Test the Connection** After connecting, verify signal integrity using an optical power meter or OTDR to ensure low loss and proper alignment. Patch cords also serve as flexible test links for maintenance and rerouting.
