

How to connect fiber optic cables to a stack of switches

Choosing the Right Fiber and SFP Modules To connect switches via fiber, you need SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ transceivers compatible with your switch ports. For short runs (under 1000 feet), multimode fiber is recommended, while single-mode fiber is better for longer distances (over 1000 feet) (). Selecting Fiber Optic Cables You can use pre-terminated fiber optic cables with LC connectors, which save installation time and reduce errors (). Each strand can carry a separate connection, but you must plan the number of strands based on the number of switches you intend to connect (). Network Topology Options Star Topology: Each switch connects directly to a central core switch. This is high-performing and easy to manage, but requires more fiber strands if you have many switches (). Daisy Chain (Cascading): Switches are connected sequentially (core → switch A → switch B → switch C). This uses fewer fibers but can create a single point of failure if an intermediate switch fails (). Physical Connection Steps Insert the SFP modules into the fiber ports of each switch. Connect the fiber optic cables between switches, ensuring send and receive strands are correctly paired (A to B, B to A) (). For pre-terminated cables, simply plug in the LC connectors; for field-terminated cables, ensure proper polishing and testing. Power on the switches and enable the corresponding VLAN interfaces if needed. Some switches may require a “no shutdo...
