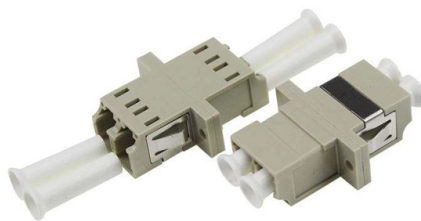


How to connect the fiber optic switch cable

To connect a fiber optic cable to a switch, you need compatible SFP/SFP+ modules, clean fiber connectors, and proper switch configuration to ensure reliable data transmission.

Required Components

- Fiber Optic Cable:** Choose single-mode for long distances or multi-mode for shorter runs.

- Connect Fiber Cable:** Plug the fiber optic cable into the SFP/SFP+ module. Ensure proper alignment: transmit (TX) on one end connects to receive (RX) on the other.
- Patch Panel Connection (Optional):** If using a patch panel, connect the other end of the fiber to the panel, which then links to the main network.

Configuration Steps

- Enable the Port:** Access the switch management interface (CLI or GUI) and enable the SFP port.
- Set Network Parameters:** Configure speed, duplex, VLANs, or link aggregation as needed to match network requirements.
- Test the Connection:** Use optical power meters or network diagnostics to verify signal integrity and data transmission.

Tips

- Use LC connectors for convenience, as they are compact and widely supported.
- For short runs, multi-mode fiber is cost-effective; for longer distances, single-mode fiber is preferred.
