

How to connect the optical module and dual fiber optic cable

Step 5: Test the Connection After installation, test the link using a fiber optic power meter or OTDR to verify signal integrity and ensure there is no significant loss (). Inspect visually for proper seating and alignment.

Additional Considerations Avoid bending the fiber beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent signal degradation (). Do not look directly into the fiber or module without eye protection (). Use proper cable management to prevent tension or tight loops that could damage the fiber (). Ensure the SFP module matches the fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and th...
