

How to connect the reserved coaxial optical cable

Connecting a Coaxial Cable

Identify the cable type: Common types include RG-6 (most common for TV and internet) and RG-59 (used for shorter runs or CCTV).

Prepare the cable: Use a coaxial cable stripper to remove about 5/8 inch of the outer jacket, exposing the braided shield. Fold the shield back carefully. Strip the inner insulation to expose the center conductor, leaving about 3/16 inch of copper.

Attach the connector: Slide a crimp-on connector over the cable, ensuring the center conductor protrudes through the pin. Crimp the connector using a ratcheting crimper to secure it firmly.

Connect to the device: Screw or push the connector onto the TV, modem, or other device input. Verify the connection is tight and the signal is stable.

Tips: Crimp-on connectors are more reliable than screw-on connectors, especially for professional or long-term installations.

Connecting an Optical Digital Audio Cable

Locate the ports: Identify the optical output on your source device (TV, Blu-ray, or console) and the optical input on your audio device (soundbar, AV receiver, or DAC). Ports are usually labeled "OPTICAL," "TOSLINK," or "DIGITAL AUDIO OUT".

Remove protective caps: Both the cable ends and device ports may have small caps to protect the optical fiber. Remove these before connecting.

Insert the cable: Align the squared-off end of the optical cable with the port and push until it clicks into place. Optical cables only fit one way.

Configure audio settings: On the source device, select the optical output in the audio settings menu. On the receiving device, select the corresponding input.

Test the connection: Power on both devices and verify that audio is transmitted correctly. Ensure the cable is not bent sharply, as this can damage the fiber.
