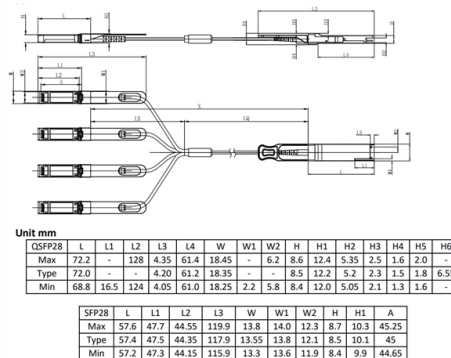

Step 4: Connect Wires Properly

- Hot wires (Live/Phase):** Connect to the Line terminals of the breaker or disconnect switch. For a 240V circuit, this usually involves two hot wires (L1 and L2).
- Neutral wire:** For single-pole breakers, connect directly to the neutral busbar; for double-pole breakers, it may be connected to the breaker itself.
- Ground wire:** Connect to the grounding terminal, often green or bonded to the metal enclosure. Ensure all wires are stripped to the correct length and securely tightened to the terminal screws to maintain a safe connection.

Step 5: Use Appropriate Breakers For full isolation, a double-pole (2P) breaker is recommended for the main switch, as it disconnects both live and neutral lines simultaneously. Single-pole breakers only disconnect one live wire, leaving th...
