

How to distinguish between the front and rear 12 cores in an OPG optical cable

Front vs. Rear Port Mapping In OPG or pass-through cables, front and rear ports represent the two ends of the same fiber path. Rear ports are mapped to front ports, often in a 1:1 correspondence for each fiber strand . For a 12-core MPO or breakout cable, the first fiber in the rear port corresponds to the first fiber in the front port, the second to the second, and so on. Proper labeling or numbering on the cable jacket or MPO connector ensures correct orientation.

Use color-coded jackets or printed legends: Some cables have printed numbers or color markers on the jacket to indicate fiber positions.
