Series Connection Considerations Maintain continuous grounding along all cables in the series to prevent voltage buildup. Use short, low-resistance conductors between clamps and the grounding busbar. Follow TIA-607-D standards and local authority requirements for bonding and grounding. If using dielectric-armored cables, grounding is not required, simplifying installation.
